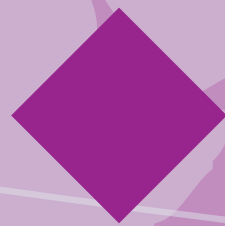

IEHK

The World Health Organization (WHO) is dedicated to saving lives. In emergency situations and in peace time. In 2006 the WHO introduced the Interagency Emergency Health Kit 2006, an update on previous kits that have been available for many years. The IEHK is deployed in the event of an emergency, a natural disaster or a man-made catastrophe.

The IEHK saves lives; it can mean the difference between life and death. The kit contents are intended to enable an immediate response to the basic health care needs of a population of 10,000 people for a three-month period in the acute phase of an emergency.

Emergency situations vary, depending on the cause and location. For example, malaria is not prevalent everywhere. The WHO has defined various modules taking these different circumstances into account. In addition to the standard kit, the supplementary modules can be ordered separately. The options include:

- A complete IEHK comprising 10 basic units, with 10 basic malaria modules and 1 supplementary unit
- Basic units with or without malaria modules - for health care workers with limited training
- Supplementary units with or without malaria modules and/or PEP modules - for physicians and senior health care workers

We are proud to have contributed to the composition of the updated emergency kits. On the introduction of the IEHK in 2006 we were awarded a long-term agreement with the WHO for their supply.

IEHK CONTENTS

Because no two emergencies are the same, depending on the local circumstances the kit contents may vary and some modules can be ordered separately. The basic unit is divided into 10 identical cartons which contain sufficient supplies, medicines and medical devices including renewables, for a population of 10,000 people for three months.

It can be supplied with or without a malaria module for treating uncomplicated falciparum malaria. These kits can be used by health care workers with only limited medical training. The composition of the supplementary modules, for physicians and senior health care workers, is as follows:

- 1 supplementary module, with medicines and medical devices and renewables for 10,000 people. This module is packaged in 17 boxes
- 1 supplementary malaria module and 1 PEP module, which is packaged in box number 11 if ordered together with the supplementary module.
